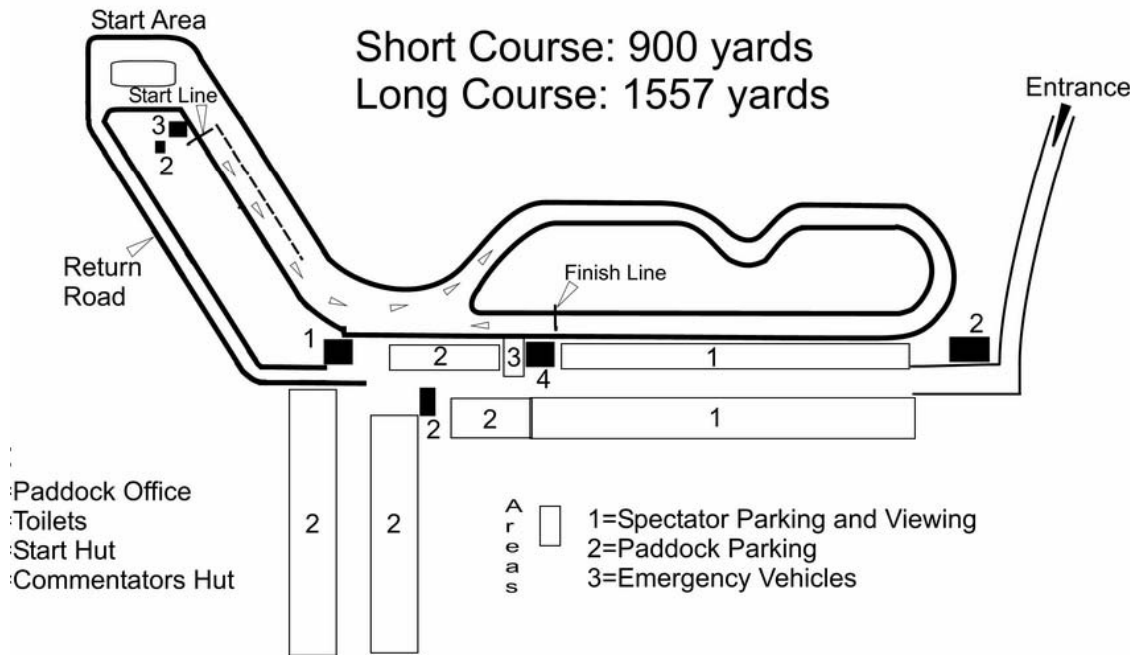


964uk – Curborough Sprint Day

The track offers a variety of layouts and is as accommodating for those who just want to spectate as for those testing their skills on the track.

The day we have is Saturday 31st October, 2009 and, to accommodate a maximum of 20 cars throughout the day giving approximately 10 runs per car, the cost is now confirmed at £45 with passenger rides being free. With a driver briefing at 10:30am and the circuit open from 11:00am until 4:30pm there's plenty of scope for an entertaining and thoroughly enjoyable day. Helmets are NOT required although they are optional and, perhaps, recommended.

There is a tea and coffee cabin on site that is normally open if we can promise good numbers (but bring some butties just in case).
